

## 2006 Commercial Group Dental Plan

By virtue of your Group Health Cooperative or Group Health Options, Inc. plan, you have access to the Commercial Group Dental Plan underwritten and administered by Washington Dental Service (WDS). The plan utilizes Washington Dental Service's PPO Network. When you receive your dental care from a PPO dentist, you will receive a higher level of benefits and will have fewer out-of-pocket costs.

<b>Class II – Restorative</b>

<b>Class III – Major</b>		
Crowns, Dentures, Partials, Bridges	50%	40%
<b>Deductible</b>		
Per calendar year. Waived on Class I services.	\$50/person \$150/family	\$50/person \$150/family
<b>Annual Maximum</b>		
Per person per calendar year.	\$1,500	\$1,500
<b>Orthodontia Coverage</b>		
Payable at 50% to a lifetime maximum of \$1,000 for eligible dependent children.

### TMJ Benefits Rider

WDS will pay the following benefits for the treatment of TMJ disorders:

- \$1,000 per covered individual, after payment of deductibles, coinsurance, and copayments
- Applicable during any calendar year
- Individual lifetime benefit is \$5,000
